Terrorists live amongst us when they're planning attacks. So naturally that means they'll try and conceal their activities. But sometimes they can leave tell-tale signs. Signs we need your help in spotting.

You can do this by remaining vigilant and reporting any suspicious activity to the police.

Suspicious activity could include:

- Passports or other documents held in different names for no obvious reason.
- Buying or storing large amounts of chemicals, fertilisers or gas cylinders for no obvious reason.
- Someone who travels for long periods of time, but is vague about where they're going.
- Someone behaving noticeably differently for no obvious reason.

We don't believe any call is a waste of time. Let specialist officers decide if the information you have is important.

If you suspect it, report it.
