Rake out all mortar including modern hard cement pointing from entirety of exposed brickwork below Kent peg tile hanging. Remove all cracked cement render at base of wall to expose sandstone blocks at footings. Effect any necessary repairs to exposed Sussex sandstone walling and replace with reclaimed walling where required. Effect repairs to ground floor Crittall window including damage to metalwork and replacement of hardwood sill and window surround. Effect any necessary repairs to brickwork using matching reclaimed bricks. Repoint the south wall in traditional heritage lime mortar throughout. Comments to RDC by 14/12/21</p>
